

SEAS Monmouth Membership Registration Policies and Rates

1. Registration Scenarios

a. Types of members

- 1) Singles – individual existing or new members
- 2) Families – two or more people living in the same household (having the same address). May be existing or new members. If one person is an existing member, the “family” membership is also considered existing.
- 3) Students – individuals completing SEAS Basic Sailing and joining for the first time, either any time in the current year or subsequent year. The following conditions apply:
 - a) The student rate applies for only one year – the year of initial membership – regardless of when during the year the student applies (specifically, September 1 has no significance). Thereafter, the person is considered an existing member. Therefore, it makes sense for students to join as soon after their Basic Sailing class as possible to get the maximum benefit of membership.
 - b) Existing members who subsequently take basic sailing will be considered existing members
 - c) Student membership cannot be part of a family membership
- 4) The new membership fee only applies to a member one time.

b. Membership status

- 1) Existing member paying for current year
- 2) Existing member paying for next year in current year
- 3) New member paying for current year prior to September 1
- 4) New member paying for current year starting September 1 of current year

c. Membership rate table

2. Membership rates:

- a. Standard single rate: \$80
- b. Discounted single rate: \$75 (for following year membership)
- c. Standard family rate: \$130
- d. Discounted family rate: \$125 (for following year membership)
- e. Student rate: \$40

3. General policies:
 - a. A registrant can only apply under one category; e.g., a student can't join with a student rate and get the next year free because he or she joins after September 1; or a student can't combine a student rate with a family rate.
